- Without health insurance, surgical treatment of carpal tunnel would cost about \$7,000 or more per hand -- or \$14,000 or more for both hands. For example, according to Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center[1 (<https://health.costhelper.com/carpal-tunnel.html#extres1>)] out-of-pocket cost calculator, a carpal tunnel release surgery for one hand would cost \$6,928, including the hospital facility fees and the doctor fees, with an uninsured discount.
- Health insurance typically covers carpal tunnel treatment, including surgery for severe cases when conservative treatments have failed. With insurance, typical expenses would include a doctor visit copay of \$10 to \$30 or more and, for surgical treatment, coinsurance of 30 percent or more that could reach \$1,000+.
